About our Presenter

Robin Bozian retired after 44 years with Southeastern Ohio Legal Services in 2021. As the project manager with SEOLS, she supervised intake, led the SEOLS VOCA program, and directed the federal Legal Assistance to Victims grant through the Office of Violence Against Women, which placed attorneys throughout Southeastern Ohio providing advice and representation to domestic violence victims. She previously served as a member of the Ohio Supreme Court Domestic Violence Advisory Committee and served on the statewide advisory board for the Office of Criminal Justice Services' Center for The Prevention of Family and Community Violence. Robin is a board member of the local DV shelter, EVE, Inc., and currently assists Ohio Domestic Violence Network with training and legislative and policy issues.

In addition to her community involvement in the area of domestic violence and grant monitoring, she has been instrumental in establishing in her community a dental clinic, a free medical clinic, a mediation program, a victim advocate program, a free legal clinic, and co-chairs the Washington county Opioid HUB and the Washington County Homeless Project (WCHP). The WCHP currently operates in the Drop-in Center, located at 274 Front Street, Marietta, Ohio.
