## WASHINGTON COUNTY FAMILY & CHILDREN FIRST / HELP ME GROW

**Help Me Grow** <u>HOME VISITING</u> is Ohio's parenting education program for expectant moms and parents/guardians with an infant under 2 years of age at enrollment. The Home Visiting program can provide services in the family's home, up to age 5, to increase healthy pregnancies; improve parenting confidence and competence; improve child health, development and readiness; and increase family connectedness to community and social support. The Parents As Teachers (PAT) curriculum is utilized. (Washington County HV also serves Morgan County).

Help Me Grow EARLY INTERVENTION program provides Service Coordination to families with children age birth to three with developmental delays or disabilities. Service Coordinators work with families to enhance the development of infants and toddlers with disabilities and enhance the capacity of families to meet their child's needs. Developmental assessments and evaluations guide the development of an Individualized Family Service Plan coordinated by the Service Coordinator. This program operates under Part C of IDEA.

### EARLY CHILDHOOD PRESCHOOL SERVICES

The Bright Beginnings Preschool offers preschool services through the Ohio Valley Educational Services in Washington County. The preschool classrooms are designed to meet the unique learning needs of typically developing children and children with disabilities for children ages 3 – 5 years old. Families who may suspect a developmental delay may enroll their child in a classroom so a screening and observation can determine if further evaluations are necessary to confirm a disability. Children who have been identified as having a disability are eligible for an Individualized Education Program where services are determined to address targeted developmental delays. Services are available in the preschool class or through itinerant services such as the home, daycare, or other settings. If you are a parent who suspects your child, over age 3, may have a developmental delay or a disability, and you would like to have a developmental screening completed with your child, contact: the Ohio Valley Educational Service Center at 2333-B St. Rt. 821, Complex 3, Bldg16-B, Marietta, Ohio 45750 or call <u>740-373-6669</u>.

#### HEAD START

The Head Start Program is a free, curriculum-based preschool education program designed to promote school readiness for children ages 3 to 5 from low-income families. The program also accepts children with special needs as well as some over income families.

Head Start also offers year-round Early Head Start that is available to eligible pregnant mothers and families until the child turns 3 and is ready to transition into Head Start or another pre-K program. Both the Head Start and Early Head Start programs offer Center and Home-Based Learning. For more information call Washington/Morgan Community Action Head Start Program 740-373-3745

#### COAD4kids

COAD4kids is a FREE resource and referral service available to all families. Parents needing child care can call COAD for a list of providers in their neighborhood.
