Motor vehicle crashes are a leading cause of death and injuries for children. When used correctly, car seats and booster seats greatly reduce the risk of hospitalization, injury, and death for children. Caregivers generally have good intentions, but Ohio law and car seats can be very confusing. This leads to most car seats being installed and/or used incorrectly which can be extremely dangerous or even fatal for a child passenger. We are here to educate, empower, and support caregivers so they can confidently use and install their child's car seat or booster seat correctly each and every time.

A team of Child Passenger Safety Technicians will host their own or attend community events to check child safety seats at no cost for families. It's a good way for parents and caregivers to get answers to car seat questions and receive education and training on how to properly install and use child safety seats.

DID YOU KNOW?

- 4 out of 5 car seats are installed incorrectly
- Motor Vehicle crashes are the leading cause of childhood fatalities in the U.S.
- It's the law! In Ohio, children must ride in a car seat or booster seat from birth until they are 8 years old or 57 inches tall. All seats must be used according to the manufacturer's instruction.
